MOBILE PHONE POLICY

Student use of mobile phone and personal devices at Allendale East Area School

In 2021 the Department for Education mandated for all Primary schools to have consistency and clarity in their mobile phone policies and provided schools with the content of it. Allendale East Area School follows this policy. Whilst it was recommended for Secondary Schools to implement similar approaches, it was not mandated.

Commencing in 2023, the Department for Education has requested that all Secondary Schools adopt the newly published policy. This is to be in effect in all schools by Term 3.

In line with the Department for Education requirement for all Government schools, students are required to abide by the new mobile phone and personal devices policy Allendale East Area School implemented the policy in Week 2 of Term 1.

For primary aged students, mobile phones and personal devices are not permitted. Please read the Rationale provided by the Department for Education and take time to read the full policy carefully when it is emailed to all families of year 3 and above. It is comprehensive, has allowances for exemptions and temporary exemptions.

Students were informed of the new rules in Week 1 and given a grace period before the introduction in Week 2.

The policy is fair, transparent and supports the health and wellbeing of all who attend and work within our educational context.
